CIEE offers 5 Japanese Language Programs to international students in Osaka University.

- 1 Elective Japanese Language Course
- ② Interdisciplinary Education Subjects
- ③ International Exchange Subjects JA (Japanese Language)
- (4) International Exchange Subjects JGU(Japanese Global Understanding)
- 5 Liberal Arts & Sciences

## Which course you may enroll ?

Eligible courses are different depending on your status. Note that you may enroll in only 1 course at a time.

Research Students→ Elective Japanese Language Course No credit

 Graduate Students → Elective Japanese Language Course No credit Interdisciplinary Education Subjects 2 credits per 1 class
International Exchange Subjects (JA) 4 credits per 1 track
International Exchange Subjects (JGU) 2 credits per 1 class

Under Graduate Students → Liberal Arts & Sciences 2 credits per 1 class

## The Elective Japanese Language Course (EJLC) level 100~700

□ Target: Enrollment is open to Graduate Students, Research Students, Special Research-Students and Special Auditors at Osaka University.

□ Teaching Style: Classes are held on online using CLE or Zoom.

□ Classes: You can choose a class suitable to your needs (Japanese proficiency, academic aims etc). However, you can only choose one level and one track.

□ Credit: No academic credit will be given for this course.

□ Registration period: Wednesday, September 30th ~ Thursday, October 22nd ※Graduate Students and some Special Auditors must check their own department's registration period.

□ Graduate students who pass level 600 or 700 in the Japanese Proficiency Level Check may sign up for the "Interdisciplinary Education Subjects", but NOT the Elective Japanese Language Course.

# International Exchange Subjects (JA) Level 100~400 (Japanese Language)

□ Target: Enrollment is open to Graduate Students, Special Auditors (OUSSEP, iExpo etc) at Osaka University.

□ Level : 4 levels ※From Introductory (level 100) to Upper Intermediate (level 400)

□ Purpose : To provide students with necessary skills in Japanese (speaking, listening, reading, writing) complehensively.

□ Credit : You may receive 4 credits in total, only if you attain the prescribed grade. □ Time : Most classes are held in 1st period (8:50 to 10:20).

- $\hfill\square$  Lessons are held 3 times a week, and you must attend ALL classes.
- If there are multiple tracks, choose one of them to enroll in.
- □ Teaching Style : Classes are held online using CLE or Zoom.
- □ Note that you may not enroll in other programs such as Elective Course at the same time.
- □ Please register for the class you take through KOAN (except some special auditors such as students of FrontierLab@OU).

## International Exchange Subjects (JGU) Advanced! (Japanese Global Understanding) Level 500 • 600

- □ Target: Enrollment is open to Graduate Students, Special Auditors (OUSSEP, iExpo etc) at Osaka University only.
- $\Box$  Level : Lower Advanced (level 500) and Upper Advanced (level 600)
- □ Purpose : To provide students with communication and comprehension skills in Japanese language through theme-specified class activity.
- □ Time : Classes are held in 1st period (8:50 to 10:20) .
- □ Teaching Style : Classes are held online on Zoom or CLE.
- □ Credit : You may recieve 2 credits per each class, only if you attain the prescribed grade.
- □ Note that you may not enroll in other programs such as Elective Course at the same time.


## ③ Attend the class
