



Guideline for **2021-2022: Winter Online Japanese Course**

1) Program Schedule

Tuesday, Jan. 11th, 2022 – Wednesday, Feb. 16th, 2022

2) Applicants

This program is intended for students who have successfully completed two semesters of formal instruction of Japanese including the development of both oral and written skills or equivalent program or students who have passed JLPT N4. Students who have passed JLPT N3 are also eligible to apply.

3) General description of the program

Online Intensive Program (Intermediate Japanese) : 2 credits

The purpose of this course is to establish a foundation for practical oral Japanese language skills by reviewing structures and vocabulary learned at the beginner level and using them in a variety of contexts. Emphasis will also be placed on establishing the foundation of practical Japanese writing skills by learning the various structures and grammar necessary for logical explanation. At the end of the course, students are required to make a final presentation based on what they have learned. The class also provides time to discuss and interact with Osaka University students on various topics.

**The capacity of the program will be 10-20 students.*

**In the case that the number of participants does not reach the capacity, this course could be canceled.*

**The course consists of 30 classes (1.5 hour / class) in the above program period.*

** The fee must be paid in YEN and by the designated due date indicated in 6), after you received a notification of acceptance and an invoice.*

Cancellation policy:

A notice of cancellation or withdrawal from the program should be provided in writing. A cancellation fee may or may not be applied based on the following:

- If the cancellation is made before the payment deadline, no cancellation fee will be charged.
- A cancellation fee of **21,000 JPY** will be charged for cancellation on or after **December 1st, 2021.**
- A cancellation fee of **42,000 JPY** will be charged for cancellation on or after **December 21st, 2021.**
- Any fees having been paid to the program will not be refunded for cancellation on or after **January 4th, 2022.**
