SCHOLARSHIP:

Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO) is an independent administrative institution established under the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology - Japan (Monbu-kagaku-sho). Osaka University has successfully obtained certain amount of financial support from JASSO for the participants of the short-term programs held in FY2024.

The JASSO grant (80,000JPY per month) will be offered for well qualified students.

1. GPA

Your JASSO GPA should be 2.3 or higher out of 3.00. Refer to the below table for the JASSO GPA.

2. Other scholarship(s)

If you are awarded, applying, or planning to apply for scholarship(s) other than the JASSO scholarship, the total amount of the (other) scholarship(s) must not exceed 80,000JPY per month.
