授業の目的と概要 / Course Objective	<p>This course is designed for the students who are the beginners of Japanese to develop their communicative fluency in all four language skills, namely listening, speaking, reading, and writing of the Japanese language. During the lecture, expressions and vocabulary of the unit will be introduced through reading comprehension of the characters' stories. In these sessions, drills, discussions, acting or various activities will be prepared and you will be requested to tell or submit the short essay (in Japanese) about yourself at the end of each unit.</p> <p>As classes will be conducted mainly in Japanese, students are expected to prepare lessons in advance. Prior to the lecture, Students are expected to watch short movies on the class web site which consists of the short drama as well as the quick introduction of the main expressions in each unit to understand how the expressions work in the daily life.</p> <p>Homework will be assigned regularly to reinforce learning. All students are expected to study Kanji according to the Kanji work sheets in and out of the class.</p>
