授業の目的と概要 / Course Objective	The objectives of JA200 are: (1) to expand ability for daily communication in both spoken and written Japanese (2) to become familiar with language structures both of spoken and written Japanese (3) to be able to orally deliver factual information/knowledge and express simple opinions (4) to gain some functional ability in comprehending and writing texts constructed with learned language structures, using hiragana, katakana and approximately 250 and more kanjis (5) to develop strategic skills for getting information about the Japanese language and promoting language acquisition through communication with Japanese speakers
履修条件・受講条件 / Requirement / Prerequisite	Students should have completed Japanese JA100 or an elementary Japanese course at other institution.
