授業の目的と概要 / Course Objective	JGU500, Exercises in Japanese Language and Global Understanding, is an integrated content-language course for intermediate and advanced students of Japanese. In each course of the Exercises in Japanese Language and Global Understanding, students will take up a theme that explores the human condition or a theme commonly faced by modern society, confirm or learn new events and situations related to the theme, and systematically reexamine them in order to gain a multifaceted and multidimensional perspective on the human condition and the state of modern society and culture. In addition, the students will acquire a multifaceted and multifaceted viewpoint of the human condition and the state of contemporary society and culture. In addition, by conducting such studies in Japanese, students will strengthen the Japanese language skills necessary for intellectual learning and inquiry, including interpretation, analysis, evaluation, reasoning, explanation, and reflection, while focusing on the theme. This class will focus on environmental issues.
