The main objective of this course is to explain the core issues of Islamic law in general, with a special focus on the aspect of family law, as this area of law still influences the modern law of many Arab and Muslim jurisdictions and Muslim believers around the world. In addition, since family law in Islam is based on different concepts and assumptions, it can be seen as a source of complication when rules and principles of Islamic law are called upon to be applied in non-Muslim countries. In order to highlight the peculiarities of Islamic family law, a comparison with Japanese family law will be made from time to time.
