


2 Essential tips for thriving on and off Campus


Attention: Bicycle accident prevention

- Bicycle insurance required
- Pay attention to rules & laws in Japan: Keep left, ride in the direction of traffic, no using of electronics/ umbrella etc. while riding, no drunk cycling, no cycling side by side, no riding double, turn on your lights at night
- Wear a helmet
