More than five absences in each class will be considered as withdrawal from the course. Three tardies or early dismissals will count as one absence. "A New Approach to Elementary Japanese Vol. 2" (Kurosio Publishers) Grammar Reference Book: "Understanding Basic Japanese Grammar"(ALC) One lecture and two sessions (90 minutes each) will be given in a week for 15 weeks. Regular attendance to all classes is required. Being absent for more than one-third of the classes will be considered as withdrawal from the course.
