授業の目的と概要/Course Objective	This course aims to deepen students' understanding of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) through case-based learning that connects global frameworks to local contexts. Focusing on SDG 3 (Health and Well-Being) and SDG 11 (Sustainable Cities and Communities), students will investigate accessibility and barrier-free environments on the University of Osaka campus. Through lectures, discussions, and field-based case studies, students will analyze challenges from multiple perspectives and develop actionable proposals for improvement.
