

- ⑥ Intensive Japanese Language Course ※

Elective Japanese Language Course Introductory ~ Upper-advanced Levels 100~700

- Exclusive for : graduate students*, research students, special research students, and special auditors at the University of Osaka.
*Only students enrolled until the last day of the class period.
- Location : **Suita Campus, IC Hall 2F**
- Classes : Students can choose any classes suitable to their needs (Japanese proficiency, academic aims, etc.).

※For levels 100~300, students can only choose one level.

※Students with Japanese proficiency level of 400 or above may take classes ranging from levels 400 to 700 across levels. However, the same skill classes cannot be taken at different levels.

◆Skill: JW(Writing), JC(Communication), JR(Reading)
○ Combination registration of JW400, JC500, and JR600 is allowed.
× Combination registration of JW500, JW600, and JW700 is not allowed.

- Credit : **No academic credit** will be given for this course.

(except some special auditors such as students of FrontierLab@OsakaU).
※If the number of applicants exceeds the limit, students may not be able to take the class.

Introductory ~ Intermediate
Level : 100~400

- Exclusive for : special auditors (OUSSEP, iExPO etc.) and graduate students at the University of Osaka. ※ Research students, special research students and FrontierLab students cannot enroll in the course.
- Location : **Toyonaka Campus**
- Time : Most classes are held during 1st period (08:50 to 10:20).
Some classes are held during 2nd period (10:30 to 12:00).
- Purpose : To provide students with necessary and comprehensive skills in Japanese (speaking, listening, reading and writing).
- Credit : Students may receive **4 credits** if satisfactory grades are attained.
 - ※ Lessons are held 3 times a week, and students must attend ALL classes.
If there are multiple tracks, students must choose one to enroll in.
(Track2 is mainly for OUSSEP students)
 - ※ Note that students may not enroll in other concurrent programs such as elective course, JGU and Interdisciplinary Education Subjects, in principle.

you don't need to take this test.


① Go to (http://nava.ciee.osaka-u.ac.jp/sim_levelcheck/)

③ On the results page, enter your Name and Student Number (If you have one). Click "Print as PDF".

④ Download the PDF and submit it to teacher by CLE or e-mail in the first class.


① Access KOAN and log in.
